

West Branch Susquehanna Restoration Coalition Meeting Report Tuesday, June 13, 2017

Opening

This meeting of the West Branch Susquehanna Restoration Coalition was called to order at 6:30 pm by Kathleen Lavelle. The meeting was held at the Clearfield County Conservation District office.

Information and Discussion Items

- Item 1: Introductions: Those present introduced themselves and stated the group(s) they represent.
- Item 2: The minutes of the April 25, 2017 meeting were distributed and reviewed. The meeting report will be changed to include a list of grants available.
- Item 3: Terry O'Connor provided handouts about the Hemlock Woolly Adelgid Beetle as well as a flyer for Bilger's Rocks. Ken Undercoffer discussed the catch and release regulations, including all tackle, being proposed for the headwaters of the West Branch of the Susquehanna where AMD recovery is well underway and wild trout populations are recovering. Kathleen Lavelle introduced the Trout Unlimited interns and discussed the upcoming summer work. She also updated everyone on the progress of the West Branch Susquehanna Recovery Benchmark II Project. Most of the streams have been sampled, but macroinvertebrate samples for some streams have not been completed due to inclement weather and dangerous conditions. These sites will be sampled next spring. Fisheries surveys will be conducted in July.
